DESCRIPTION: This is an applied field clinic designed to enhance the shooters ability to make well aimed shots with a high degree of 1st round hits under field conditions. The wind is the single component of each firing solution that is never constant. The correct wind call will have the greatest effect on the impact of the projectile on its intended target. Depending on the time of day, elevation, type of eco system or weather pattern, the shooter will have to adapt to the current conditions. This enhanced course focuses on reading the wind and environmental conditions that impact the flight of your projectile and applying the observations to the firing solution.

Tips and techniques of marksmanship will be discussed, demonstrated and practiced.
